**GOOD PROGRESS ON IMPLEMENTATION OF MOT'S
23 INITIATIVES TO IMPROVE LRT SAFETY AND SECURITY**

KUALA LUMPUR, 23 SEPTEMBER 2021 – Prasarana Malaysia Berhad (Prasarana) today hosted a briefing session for YB Datuk Seri Dr Wee Ka Siong, Minister of Transport and the delegation from the Ministry of Transport and Agensi Pengangkutan Awam Darat (APAD) at Kompleks Rapid Rail Subang where it shared the progress of the twenty-three (23) initiatives to improve the procedures and operating guidelines for LRT Kelana Jaya Line.

“Prasarana would like to thank YB Minister who has shown great interest and support from the very start, where he spent a lot of time at Hospital Kuala Lumpur to monitor the progress and offer aid and comfort to the affected passengers. We also would like to thank the Ministry of Transport and APAD for their guidance in our efforts to carry out the recommendations,” said Mohd Azharuddin Mat Sah, Prasarana’s President and Group Chief Executive Officer.

“During the session, YB Minister shared plenty of ideas, wisdom, and words of encouragement, which I hope will spur the team to work harder in fulfilling the remaining recommendations; especially the mid-term initiatives that we need to deliver by December.

As for the long-term measures, we are working with our stakeholders and relevant authorities to implement them progressively as some of it requires additional investment and technical expertise from various quarters,” Azharuddin added.

In the incident on 24 May, an empty LRT train collided with another carrying 139 passengers in a tunnel between the LRT Kampung Baru and KLCC stations.
